Special City Council Meeting

The City Council of the City of Southmayd, Texas met on this date at 6:00 p.m. for a Special City Council Meeting. City Council members present were Mayor Debra Thomsson, Mayor Pro Tem Michael Horstman, Mark Everett, Briana Monroe, and Teresa Miller.

1. Roll Call/Call to Order.

The Special Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

Councilmember Everett led Pledge to Flag and prayer.

2. Discuss, consider, and possible action on the joint election contract for election services with Grayson County for the May 2, 2026, General Election.

Mayor Pro Tem Horstman made a motion to accept the joint election contract with Grayson County for the May 2, 2026, General Election not to exceed \$12,000.00. Councilmember Everett seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

3. Discuss, consider, and possible action on approval of the Notice of General Election to be held on May 2, 2026.

Councilmember Everett made a motion to approve the Notice of General Election to be held on May 2, 2026, General Election. Councilmember Monroe seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

4. Discuss, consider, and possible action on approval of the Order of Elections for the May 2, 2026, General Election.

Mayor Pro Tem Horstman made a motion to approve the Order of Elections for the May 2, 2026, General Election. Councilmember Miller seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

5. Discuss, consider, and possible action on adopting Ordinance 468 ordering a general election to be held on the 2nd of May 2026, for three city council members at-large for a two-year term of office.

Councilmember Everett made a motion to adopt Ordinance 468 ordering a general election to be held on the 2nd of May 2026. Mayor Pro Tem Horstman seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

6. Discuss, consider, and possible action on the Southmayd Interconnection Change Order #1.

Councilmember Everett made a motion to approve the Southmayd Interconnection Change Order #1 with budget amendment if needed. Mayor Pro Tem Horstman seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

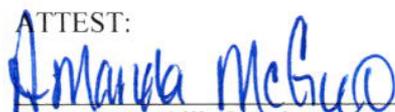
